

Notes to the Application form for registration under the Mauritian Diaspora Scheme

- 1. The Mauritian Diaspora member should not be a dependent child. Dependent child is defined as the child, including the step child or lawfully adopted child, under 24 years of age.
- 2. Applicant should indicate the total number of years spent living and working abroad, excluding years of study.
- 3. Applicant should submit his/her curriculum vitae including details of education and qualifications.
- 4. Professionals should include details of past employers, positions held and responsibility in previous 10 years in employment in their Curriculum vitae.
- 5. Professionals should also submit at least 2 reference letters from previous employers.
- 6. Self- employed should include details of their current activity in the curriculum vitae.
- 7. Self-employed should submit a business plan including expected initial investment and expected annual business income.
- 8. Dependents are defined as spouse (including Common Law Partner) and children, including step children or lawfully adopted children, under 24 years of age.
